

FIDCAMPUS CALL FOR APPLICATION

A project initiated by FIDMarseille

FIDMarseille, which will be celebrating its 36th edition from 8th to 13th July, 2025, is offering a training residency from 7th to 13th July, 2025.

Launched in 2013, the FIDCampus is a week-long of residency, training and exchanges for students at the end of their studies (in cinema and art) and young European and international filmmakers. Each year, 12 to 14 young filmmakers are selected on the basis of their latest film and their motivation, and take part in an intensive training programme. In 2024, 12 young filmmakers representing 10 countries and 3 continents were selected from around 150 applications received.

The programme is designed as a professional springboard between the end of studies and the start of a career - often a difficult period for young filmmakers.

This experience, which is always very rewarding, speeds up their integration into the professional world of cinema, giving them the opportunity to exchange ideas with local and international filmmakers and producers, and to meet young colleagues and future collaborators. Many of the talents discovered at FIDCampus have returned to Marseille to develop their projects or shoot their films. Several of them were later programmed at FIDMarseille and/or at festivals around the world.

During the residency, participants are invited to:

- Participate in two days of tutoring and group discussions led by recognised professionals [Caroline Champetier, Miguel Gomes, Alice Rohrwacher, Stefano Savona, among others, have already been experts at the FIDCampus].

- Privileged meetings with directors, programmers and producers invited to the festival Take part in discussions with FIDMarseille programmers and organisers Attend masterclasses with internationally renowned directors (Ingrid Caven, Whit Stillman, Laure Prouvost, Mathieu Amalric, Apichatpong Weerasethakul...Radu Jude in 2025)
- Attend public talks by FIDLab project leaders
 Access to the screenings of films in the FIDMarseille programme

Will be offered for each participant:

- Round trip ticket
- Pick up at the airport
- 8 nights accommodation in Marseille
- Daily catering
- Transportation and activities related to the program
- Festival pass giving access to the whole programming









FIDCAMPUS CALL FOR APPLICATION

Each school/institution can send **15 applications maximum**. In order to register, each director will need to:

- 1. Create a VP user account on Eventival if they do not have one already: https://vp.eventival.com/fidmarseille/2025/
- 2. Notify Clara Avazeri of the creation of this account by sending an email to the following address: fidcampus@fidmarseille.org
- 3. Clara Avazeri will give each participant access to the online registration form.

Each participant may only submit **one application** (generally for the last film they made and whose duration will be less than 60 minutes). The application deadline is the **28**th **February**, **2025**.

Selection is not systematic. The FIDMarseille selection committee may select up to one director per school or partner, based on the film submitted and individual motivations.
